Pre-Recorded Music... how's that going to be different?

- You will be able to preview the playlist (<https://matesanddates.org/playlists>) and give us feedback to suggest changes before the dance. (You can send comments via the Feedback link on the website up to a week before the dance). There will be no requests accepted at the dance.
- Each song is automatically preceded by a 2 second announcement telling everyone what dance it is (e.g. 'This is a Foxtrot') which also allows some time to get up to dance or sit down before the next dance.
- Each table will have at least 3 copies of the playlist. Each playlist has 4 checkboxes for each song where you can rate it. Checking the 'Very Happy Face' check box will ensure that song returns to future playlists and checking the 'Very Frowny Face' check box will invite that song to retire and not return. Writing your favorites (song and performer) on the back will help us add them to the library for future dances. Leave the annotated playlists on the table and the Music Team will collect them to incorporate your feedback.

FYI: Members vs Guests

If you have not paid your annual membership, you are a guest. Guests, according to our bylaws, must be invited by a member. Members can self register and can also register their guests on the website. Guests have no self-registration capability on the website. A guest can fill out and mail in an offline (paper) guest registration form but the form must have the names of their member hosts and they must sit at the same table as their inviting host members.
